BEIJING



Located in the North, is the capital of China and home to over 14 million people, 10 million bicycles and 3 million vehicles. It is China's most important political, cultural and financial center. As the seat of power of Chinese emperors throughout the centuries, Beijing is steeped in history. Nowhere else can you get a more concentrated impression of the old and new China? While your minds are still lingering with architectural miracles of Forbidden City and Great Wall of China, your eyes are also shocked by the rising constructions of the Olympic Village for the 2008 Summer Olympic Game.

Day1: Beijing (D)

Arrival in Beijing, transport to Beijing International Hotel, welcome dinner, and briefing by your Chinese National Guide

Day 2: Beijing (B, L, D)

In the morning, delegates will visit **Guang Anmen Hospital of Traditional Chinese Medicine**, learning about theories as well as clinical practices adopted by this great alternative medicine with thousands of years of history.

Guang Anmen Hospital is a clinical pharmacological research base of Chinese herbs, a part of Traditional Medicine Cooperative Center organized by WHO.



In the afternoon, a visit to the world-renowned **Forbidden City** will have you overwhelmed by this largest imperial palace complex no comparable by the rest of the world. Strolling among the courtyard, seeing those incredibly engraved pillars and roof ceilings, your minds will be racing with the history of many rises and downs of Chinese dynasties.



Following an authentic Chinese local dinner, you definitely have to see the great stage performance.” **Kung fu**” A panorama combines martial art, acrobatic and many other artistic forms. As Metropolis Magazine put it: *‘The legend of Kungfu takes Beijing into a new era of modern theatrical performance’*

Day 3: Beijing (B, L, D)

The morning visit to the **Great Wall of China** will absolutely perfect your Beijing trip. A defensive work of thousands of miles, a historical wonder of Chinese people’s essence, your dream of climbing the wall will be turned into reality. Reaching its highest tower, you will appreciate the beauty, you are on the wall!!

In the afternoon, will pay a visit to the **Summer Palace**. Summer Palace is the largest and most significant imperial garden in China. Its first construction could be dated back to 800 years ago, and its latest reconstruction was in 1903. It was the most favorable summer resort for Chinese Emperors and the Empress Dowager Cixi in the last dynasty.

The **Peking Duck Banquet** is absolutely a perfect ending to today’s all events. As the locals say that you never claim to have been in Beijing without trying the Peking duck. With a history of over 200 years, the duck meal used to be served only to the royals families. From raising the ducks to the cooking methods, a restrictive process is practiced. Eating is believing. You are never aware of being full while till gets shocked by everything served.

Day 4: Beijing (B, L, D)

In the afternoon, delegates will visit to a **traditional local neighborhood** in Beijing. This is a great chance for delegates to get have a close interaction with Chinese families, chat with local people to learn about their everyday life and observe disparities and similarities that are exist between the nations. Delegates will also be invited to learn how to cook Chinese foods, while it’s more for friendship than just a lesson. Understanding each other, finding the best and most out of each other, it is a real people to people moment. Dinner will be served at the local families.

XI'AN

Upon arrival, pay a brief visit to the **City Wall**

The city wall, 14 kilometers long, is one of the only two 600-year-old city walls still in good shape in China.

Xian, meaning the Western Peace, records the great changes of the Chinese nation just like a living history book. Called Chang'an in ancient times, Xian is one of the birthplaces of the ancient civilization of the Yellow River Reaches. During Xian's 3,100 year development, 13 dynasties such as Western Zhou (11th century BC - 771 BC), Qin (221 BC - 206 BC), Western Han (206 BC - 24 AD) and Tang (618 - 907) placed their capitals here. So far, Xian enjoys equal fame with Athens, Cairo, and Rome as one of the four major ancient civilization capitals. Within the country, the cultural and historical significance of the area, as well as the abundant relics and sites, help Xian enjoy the laudatory title of 'Natural History Museum'.

Day 5: Xi'an (B, L)

Morning visit to the **Big Wild Goose Pagoda** that is a

1200-year-old functioning Buddhism temple Dayan Pagoda is also known as the Big Wild Goose Pagoda. This seven-story, 211 foot structure, built in 652 AD and offers a spectacular view of the ancient city wall.

Afternoon visit to the **Terra Cotta Warriors Museum**

The Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses are the most significant archeological excavations of the 20th century. Work is ongoing at this site, which is around 1.5 kilometers east of Emperor Qin Shi Huang's Mausoleum, Lintong County, Shaanxi province. It is a sight not to be missed by any visitor to China. On the way back to the city, delegates will visit a **local farmer's family**. A great opportunity for you to learn the rural life of China! Delegates will have an **open evening** today.

Day 6: Xi'an (B, L, D)

In the morning, delegates will visit **Xian Children's Welfare Institute (An Orphanage)**. People said that the "one child family policy" has spoiled a whole generation of people born after 1978. But we do have kids who need more care and love from the whole society, such as those living in the orphanages. This is going to be a heart-touching experience for all of you!



In the afternoon, you will have a visit to the **Great Mosque and Market**, The Great Mosque in Xian is one of the oldest, largest and best-preserved Islamic mosques in China and its location is northwest of the Drum Tower (Gu Lou) on Huajue Lane. Following the visit, will also have some bargaining shopping opportunities at the market nearby.

Day 1, Nov 22, Saturday, Wuhan-Chong Qing

Delegates will have a leisure morning, then drive to the airport and fly to Chong Qing

Upon your arrival in Chong Qing, met by the local guide and check into the luxury hotel. Dinner at hand selected local restaurant.

Day 2, Nov 23, Sunday, Chong Qing

Today, delegates will have a wonderful day trip in Chong Qing, including **General Stillwell Museum's World War II**, the lovely **Panda Bear Garden** where you will see the cute Panda Bear, "National Treasure of China"!

Last but not least, will be a visit to the **Three Gorges Museum**, a great place for you to get a better understanding of this world-famous project before you actually see it.

Lunch and dinner at local restaurant.

Board **Victoria Cruises' Katarina** to begin your down stream cruise in your outside cabin with private balcony.

Day 3, Nov24, Monday, Yangtze River Cruise

Enjoy a leisure trip in the morning, and then have the shore excursion at the **Feng Du “Ghost “City**. A scenic spot actually known for its rich history, terrific view of Yangtze River! Lunch and dinner on board the ship.

Day 4, Nov 25, Tuesday, Yangtze River Cruise

Unforgettable scenery unfolds as you cruise through the first of the fabled Three Gorges: Qutang Gorge. At Wuhan, transfer to a cruiser for an excursion up the Daning River to view its **splendid Small Gorges**. Continue by Sampan to the picturesque mini-gorges of the Ma Du River. Alternatively, your excursion may be on **Shennong Stream** with impressive small gorges. Finally, sail through the dramatic Three Gorges ship lock. Lunch and dinner on board the ship.

Day 5, Nov 26, Wednesday, Yangtze River Cruise, Yi Chang to Shanghai

Today, will visit the **Three Gorges Dam**, the world’s largest hydroelectric project. Cruise ends at Yi Chang city, then board a flight to Shang Hai.

Upon your arrival in Shanghai, get transferred to the **Bund Riverside Hotel**, open evening. Dinner own your own.

Day 6, Nov 27, Thursday, flying home

Check out of the hotel, and depart for the airport, catch your flight home!
